But it seems there are some ultra-obsessed enthusiasts for whom quality of escape rooms is the most important factor when deciding where to go on holiday. If thats you, then heres a quick run-down of the most often recommended hotspots:The Netherlands: arguably the densest concentration of escape game quality in Europe.Barcelona: until recently relatively undiscovered by enthusiasts outside the country, Barcelona is the hub of the thriving and innovative escape room industry in Spain.Athens: with a host of remarkably elaborate games, many significantly longer than 60 minutes, the Greek capital is one of the top destinations for games.
